SECTION VIII - FIRST AID

Skin: If the chemical got onto the clothed portion of the body, remove the contaminated clothes as quickly as possible, protecting your own hands and body. Place the victim under a deluge shower. If the chemical touches the victim's exposed skin, such as the hands: Gently and thoroughly wash the contaminated skin with running water and non-abrasive soap. COLD water may be used. If irritation persists, seek medical attention. Wash contaminated clothing before reusing.
Inhalation: Allow the victim to rest in a well ventilated area. Seek immediate medical attention.
Ingestion: DO NOT induce vomiting. If the victim is not breathing, perform mouth-to-mouth resuscitation. Seek immediate medical attention.
